Notes

The see of Emly was united to Cashel in 1559 and Waterford & Lismore, which had been united since time immemorial, were united to Cashel & Emly in 1833.

The great majority of the diocesan records were destroyed in the fire in the Public Record Office of Ireland in 1922. Herbert Wood *A Guide to the Records Deposited in the Public Record Office of Ireland* (Dublin 1919) is largely a catalogue of the material which was destroyed in 1922.
