Notes: This parish originally united as Kilwaughter and Carincastle, was subsequently united with All Saints Craighyhill or Larne & Inver, and is now known as Cairncastle & Kilwaughter. The parish church is St Patrick's Cairncastle.

A volume comprising a combined register of baptisms 1821-1882; marriages 1823-1844 and burials 1824-1882, was destroyed in the fire at the Public Records Office of Ireland in 1922.
