- 2 . Minutes of the managing committee and related papers concerning the renovation of the Recreation Hall (parish hall) including a fundraising effort 1956-58 and architectural elevations of the building, 1957. 1947-1958 inclusive.
- 3 . Miscellaneous papers about parish life including a copy letter book of outward letters on behalf of the vestry, 1959-1977; information and reports on the church fabric and repairs; proposals for a new cemetery; detailed historical notes compiled for the 150th anniversary of the church, 1997, and the resignation of the rector, Revd Paula Halliday, because she was married to another cleric but church rules prevented them living in the same house; and they relocated to the USA, 2000. 1956-2000 inclusive
- 4 . Detailed papers including drawings for ambitious and valiant plans to reuse and redevelop the Old Rectory, in what became known as 'The Old Rectory Project'. The efforts never came to anything and the building was sold by the parish in 2014. 1991-2010 inclusive.
- 5 . Papers including minutes and copy drawings of the New Rectory for Crosspatrick and Carnew, which corresponds with similar file in the Crosspatrick collection, P.547.15. 2002-2008.
- 6 . Correspondence and related papers concerning the bequest of Miss Marianne Hamilton (died 1949) and the sale of a property, Thorn Cottage, on Carnew Main Street, by the select vestry, 2005-2006.
