Includes a number of items probably lodged in the parish vestry for safe keeping including the will of one Rowland Carter, York, 1740; a detailed list of events in the city of Cork, commencing with the city being placed "under the protection of Major General Myers" in 1799, the executions of army deserters, "armed ruffians barbarously and inhumanly piking someone to death"; the departure of the French fleet and a Charity Sermon to be preached in St Paul's church; a return of the maintenance account for St Nicholas Mall Industrial School, listing 55 children, 1892.1726-1953
- 2 . Extensive and detailed run of churchwarden's accounts for the period 1807-1826, including a 'Return of the Valuation of Several New Houses in the Parish', 1807; with detailed loose accounts including poor payments, 1808-1826; an undated list of the poor, probably link to the same period and also including a particularly detailed daily minister's money and church rate payments made during the period September-November 1812.
